- 1. I thought there was consensus to exclude interpretative rules; perhaps I missed it, but didn't see that here, and continue to think it is importance. Under the law, "guidance" is not a clear, precise, or recognized form of agency action—we should be clear what we're talking about, and ACUS should use terminology that is consistent with the APA.
- 2. In recommendation 4, the beginning of the sentence referring to parties' freedom "to take a lawful approach" is a bit confusing; the sentence would benefit from re-arranging so the phrase refers in full to "a lawful approach different than the one suggested in the guidance document."
- 3. I found recommendations 8(b) and (c) a bit hard to follow also.
